A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF GULL LAKE TO PROVIDE FOR THE REMOVAL OF GRASS AND WEEDS ON PUBLIC AND PRIVATE PROPERTY.

Pursuant to section 160 of the Municipal Government Act 1980 of the Province of Alberta, the Council of the Summer Village of Gull Lake, duly assembled, enact as follows:

**WHEREAS**, Council is desirous that grass and weed growth within the Village be properly controlled and maintained:

**AND WHEREAS**, in the event the owner, lessee or tenant fails to cut or control weed and grass growth either on his own property or property that abuts or flanks his property, the Village may enter upon the land and may cut the grass and weeds or otherwise take the necessary action to control the growth of grass and weeds on the premises and recover the cost of the work done from the respective property owner, lessee or tenant.

**THEREFORE** be it resolved that the Village or any person authorized by the Village be permitted to enter upon any land within the Village and carry out the necessary work pursuant to this by-law in accordance with the following conditions:

- (a) notification to the respective property owner of not less than fourteen (14) days of the requirements of this by-law and the intention of the Village to proceed accordingly:
- (b) in the event the property owner fails to carry out the required corrective measures, the Village or any person authorized by the Village may carry out the work and charge the cost of the work done to the property owner:
- (c) failure of the property owner to remit payment of the account for costs assessed within thirty (30) days of the date of issue of the said account will result in the costs being charged against the property as taxes dues and owing and collect it as such.

READ a FIRST time this 12th day of August, A.D., 1983.

READ a SECOND time this 12th day of August, A.D., 1983.

WITH THE UNANIMOUS CONSENT of Council, READ a THIRD time this 12th day of August, A.D., 1983, and finally passed.
