

BY-LAW NO. 248

A By-Law of the Summer Village of Gull Lake for the purpose of preventing the riding of horses along the beach front area of Gull Lake.

Pursuant to and under authority of section 161(a) of the Municipal Government Act of the Province of Alberta, the Council of the Summer Village of Gull Lake, duly assembled, enact as follows:

1. For the purpose of this By-Law the regulated area means: the immediate beach front extending from the waters edge up to the high water level of the private properties lying within the legal boundaries of the Summer Village of Gull Lake.
2. No person shall keep, maintain, confine, tether, ride or permit to maintain, confine, tether or die any horse or horses in the areas herein described between the period May 15 to September 15 of any year in which this by-law remains in full force and effect.
3. Any person contravening the provisions of the By-Law shall on summary conviction be liable to a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00).

This By-Law shall take effect upon the final reading thereof.

Read a SECOND time in Council this 11th day of June, A.D., 1982.

Read a THIRD time in Council and finally passed this 11th day of June, A.D., 1982.
