A BY-LAW OF THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF GULL LAKE IN THE PROVINCE OF ALBERTA, TO AUTHORIZE PERSONS TO OPERATE OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES, AND TO REGULATE THE MANNER AND TIME OF USE THEREOF WITHIN THE SUMMER VILLAGE OF GULL LAKE.

Under the provisions and authority of the Off-Highway Vehicle Act being Chapter 0-4, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980 and amendments thereto, the Council of the Summer Village of Gull Lake hereby enacts as follows:

**1. DEFINITIONS**

In this By-Law the terms and expressions used shall be as defined in Section 1 of the Highway Traffic Act and amendments thereto being Chapter H-7, Revised Statutes of Alberta 1980 and as defined in the Definition Section 1(1) of the Off-Highway Vehicle Act, R.S.A. 1980.

**2. AUTHORITY TO OPERATE**

Except as hereinafter prohibited, an Off-Highway Vehicle may be operated on any street or lane within the limits of the Summer Village of Gull Lake.

**3. PROHIBITIONS**

No person shall:

- (a) operate an Off-Highway Vehicle at any time between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 of the next morning (12:00 midnight to 7:00 a.m.).
- (b) operate an Off-Highway Vehicle at a rate of speed greater than 25 kilometers per hour (25 kph).

**4. BREACH OF PROVISIONS**

Any person guilty of an infraction or breach of provisions of this By-Law, shall upon summary conviction before a Justice of the Peace be liable to the penalties provided for in By-Law No. 122 of the Summer Village of Gull Lake.

5. By-Law No. 174 of the Summer Village of Gull Lake is hereby repealed.

6. This By-Law shall come into force immediately upon passing hereof.
